

# **Tuxedo Park Tree Advisory Board (TPTAB) sponsored photo competition: guidelines for the photographer**

## **How to enter**

Residents of Tuxedo Park may submit photographs online through our website at [www.tptreeboard.org](http://www.tptreeboard.org). Multiple photos may be submitted. In order for the winning image to be displayed without being stretched or distorted, photographs must be rectangular/horizontal and submitted in .jpg or .tiff format, edited for web, 2,000 pixels wide, in color, sepia or b/w.

High-quality scans of non-digital photographs are acceptable. Digital photographs should be taken at the highest resolution possible, or at least 300 dpi at 3,000 pixels on the longest side.

Please provide your full name, email address and telephone number with each submission.

The TPTAB reserves the right (without further consultation with you) to crop the winning photo if necessary to optimize the display.

## **Copyright**

You retain your rights to your photograph; however, by entering the contest, you grant the TPTAB (and those authorized by TPTAB) a royalty/fee-free, world-wide, perpetual, non-exclusive license to publicly display, distribute, reproduce and create derivative works of the entries, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or later developed, for any TPTAB purpose, including, but not limited to, advertising and promotion of the TPTAB cause and its website, exhibition, and any commercial products, including but not limited to TPTAB publications. Any photograph reproduced will include a photographer credit as feasible. The TPTAB will not be required to pay any consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such uses.

## **Entry deadline**

Entries must be received through [www.tptreeboard.org](http://www.tptreeboard.org) by 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time on 25<sup>th</sup> day of each month.

The winner will be announced and posted on [www.tptreeboard.org](http://www.tptreeboard.org) the following month.

Photo entries will be judged based on creativity, quality, originality, and relevance to the cause of promoting tree and environmental health of Tuxedo Park. The judges will be members of the TPTAB and our photography consultant, Joseph Ng.
